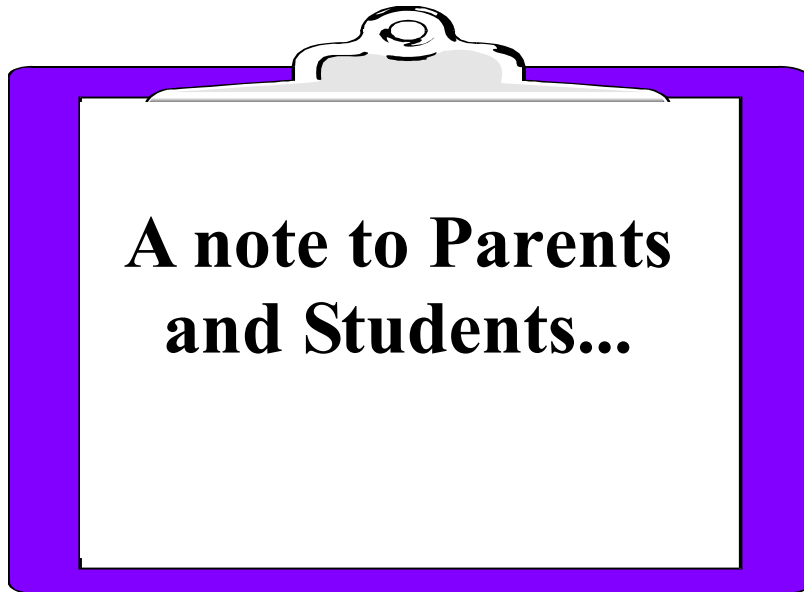


# Tyrone Elementary School Rules and Regulations



One of the beliefs of the Tyrone Elementary School staff is:  
**Behavior affects learning.**

Maintaining this belief and with the personal safety of our students in mind, the staff at Tyrone Elementary School has developed a number of expected behaviors for students while at school.

Please read the following pages together, discuss the contents, sign and return the tear off portion at the end of this section.

We ask that parents help their children understand that behind each rule is a safety issue. It is our hope that by working together, we can help students to make good choices during the day and guarantee all students the excellent learning climate they deserve.

1. **Follow directions the first time.**
2. **Use appropriate language at all times.**
3. **No gum is allowed on school property.**
4. **Treat each other with respect.**
5. **Treat the school equipment with respect.**



1. Children who bring out play equipment are responsible for that equipment.
2. Specific rules for individual pieces of equipment must be followed:
  - Slides:**
    1. One person may be on the ladder at a time.
    2. One person may go down the slide at a time.
    3. Children must go down the slide feet first.
    4. Children may not climb up the slide
  - Swings:**
    1. One person to a swing.
    2. The swing must be stopped before getting off.
    3. Children must sit on the swing.
    4. Children must not hook onto another swing or swing sideways.



## **Lunchtime Behavior in the Gym/Lunchroom**

1. Children will enter the lunchroom quietly.
2. Children will use good table manners.
3. Children will speak in conversational tones.
4. Children will show respect for the lunchroom aides and follow their directions at all times.
5. Children will clear their tables **AFTER** their classroom teacher arrives to dismiss them from lunch
6. Children will put their lunch containers in the classroom baskets on the way out of the gym.

## **Lunchtime Behavior in the Classroom**

1. Children will show respect for the lunchroom aides and follow their directions at all times. They will find something quiet to do during recess time, and remain in that general area until they are dismissed to the gym for lunch.
2. Children will follow the rules of the classroom.
3. Children must have permission to leave the room.

# Behavior While Entering and Leaving School



1. Children will enter the school by the assigned doors.
2. Entry time is 8:05. The school day is over at 2:56. A child is considered tardy if they are not **in their classroom** when the tardy bell rings at 8:10.
3. Children may stand in the hallway only when the weather conditions warrant it. During winter months students will be allowed in if the temperature is below 10 degrees Fahrenheit Safety squad members will assist the students.
4. Children will meet parents, brothers, sisters and friends outside the building at dismissal time.
5. If a student has not been picked up 15 minutes after dismissal, **the student will be put into the Latchkey Program and the parent will be charged a \$10.00 fee for using the program while not registered and then an hourly rate until the student is picked**

## Hallway Behavior

1. Individual children will walk on the right side of the hallway and stairways.
2. Children will keep their hands away from walls and displays.
3. Children will speak in conversational tones.
4. When classes move through the hallways they will go quietly.
5. Personal space will be respected. There will be no pushing, shoving or running. Students will walk down steps at all times, no jumping.



# Consequences



If a rule is broken, the following consequences will be given:

1. A lunch detention will be given. A card explaining what your child did to earn the detention will be stapled to your child's planner. A detention can be given for any of the following reasons:

**Disregarding staff directions/arguing with staff**

**Inappropriate language**

**Bullying**

**Lying**

**Classroom disruption**

**Lack of respect for others**

**Instigating**

**Too many tardies**

2. A possible in-school suspension or out-of-school suspension can be given if there is a continual behavior problem or severe infraction of the rules.

\*If a lunch detention is not served for an unexcused reason, another detention will be given.

\*If a child skips his detention **more than one time**, they will earn one week of lunch detentions.

\*If a child earns 5 lunch detentions, a mandatory meeting will be set up with the child's parents, relevant teachers, principal, and social worker. **If a parent misses the meeting, the child will be isolated from school until the meeting is held.**
