GENERAL INFORMATION

School will be in-person learning and virtual details will be forth coming. The first day of school will be Tuesday, September 7th. Students who are not eating breakfast will enter the building at 8:00 a.m. Our first class will begin at 8:05 a.m. Breakfast is served from 7:35 a.m. to 7:50 a.m. Breakfast will not be served after 7:50 a.m. Strict Covid-19 protocols will be in place (please see attached documents). Students and staff will have their temperature checked upon admittance into the building. Mask are mandatory for all students and staff upon entry and during the entire school day. The school day will end at 3:15 p.m.

Students are allowed to bring cell phones to school, but for security reasons cell phones are collected by their teacher at the beginning of the day and returned to the student at the end of the day.

Fridays are our SPIRIT WEAR days. Spirit wear consists of any Tyrone shirt, Beacon shirt, Harper Woods shirt, or ANY college/university shirt. Professional sport teams such as Lions, or Pistons are not considered spirit wear.

DRESS CODE

Students must wear a solid colored, polo style (collared) shirt in either: Dark Hunter, Forest Green, or White. Students may wear khakis, jeans, cargo pants, dress pants, shorts and skirts in a manner appropriate for school. Students cannot wear sweatpants, yoga pants, flip flops, slides, or open toe sandals. All items must be appropriate for a school environment and worn in the manner for which they were intended.
