Dear Parent or Guardian:

On behalf of The School District of the City of Harper Woods, Chartwell is committed to the students and families of our district. Although you have selected a 100% virtual learning pathway for your child this semester, they are still entitled to healthy and nutritious meals. As Director, I will begin implementing food distribution for all virtual students. What this means is that all students are eligible for free breakfast, lunch, snack, and supper for any school calendar day for the duration of their time as virtual students.

Food Distribution will be every Tuesday from 2pm-4pm, beginning September 21st, at Harper Woods High School, Door B, which is located on the North end of the lot, on the Eastland side, and will consist of 5 complete breakfasts and 5 complete lunches, 5 snacks and 5 suppers. Meals will not be served on weekends, breaks or days school is not in session.

The requirement for you is very simple, by every Friday starting the 17th, and every Friday thereafter, just call and place your order for your student or students, as well as a pick-up time. You can call any day through the week, and we will record the information and have it ready for you.
