Shantell Johnson whose child is in the second-grade at Beacon, expressed concerns about the frequent changes in leadership, noting that the school has had three principals in the past few years. She seeks clarification on how to ensure stable leadership if she decides to enroll her child at Tyrone as well. Additionally, she addressed concerns regarding late communication through ClassDojo, which has left her with insufficient time to arrange alternative pick-up accommodations, as well as concerns about erratic driving behavior by other parents during pick-up/drop-off.
